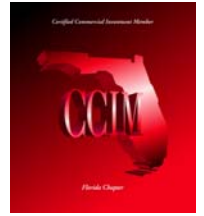

## 2011 FL CCIM Scholarship Program Overview

### ELIGIBILITY:

1. All applicants must be actively involved in commercial real estate - sales, leasing, development, consulting, finance, etc.
2. All applicants must be a current member in good standing of the CCIM Institute and the Florida CCIM Chapter before submitting a scholarship application. Note: Education Foundation CI-101 Scholarship applicants only need to be a member for FL CCIM. Florida CCIM Membership applications can be found on the website [www.flccim.com](http://www.flccim.com).
3. Each applicant must have a FL Chapter CCIM Designee Mentor. (Mentors are chosen by applicant or assigned by District Chairman. The Mentor must be a current Chapter and Institute member in good standing.)
4. Recipients must serve on a District Committee during the year of their award. (Committee assignment made by the District President.)

### PROCEDURES:

1. Download the FL CCIM Scholarship application from the FL CCIM website.
2. Fill in and attach all required information and forms. Incomplete applications will not be accepted.
3. Submit completed applications to your local District Scholarship Chair. (You can submit for more than one Scholarship type).
4. The District Board will review all submitted applications for completeness.
5. District Board will then make their recommendations, but will submit ALL fully complete applications to the FL CCIM Chairman for approval.
6. FL CCIM Chairman will determine the scholarship winners.
7. Winning applications are then submitted by the FL CCIM Chapter Scholarship Chairman to the CCIM Institute for processing.
8. FL CCIM Chairman will announce Scholarship awardees by Dec 31, 2010.
9. Scholarships are not officially awarded until the *Scholarship Agreement* form is signed and returned by the awardees to the FL CCIM Chairman.

## **IMPORTANT CRITERIA:**

1. All applicants will pay the entire course tuition at time of Registration. Once the course is successfully completed, submit course certificate to the FL CCIM Chair for re-imbusement in the amount of the awarded scholarship.
2. Failing a course will result in the scholarship NOT being awarded.
3. Scholarship may not be used for any Online Courses or Challenge Exams.
4. All award recipients MUST register for their desired course by March 31st 2011, but the course does not need to be completed until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2011. Those not registered by this date will forfeit their Scholarship.
5. Scholarships may only be used in the year awarded – No Exceptions.
6. Scholarships may not be used retroactively nor redeemed for cash.
